What: Host housing is needed for the professional men's and women's bicycle racing teams competing at the 2010 Glencoe Grand Prix – an opportunity for families in the area to connect with National Champions, Olympians, future Olympians, and hard-working racers striving to fulfill dreams in professional bike racing.

When: August 13-14.

We are in search of families who live within a 30-minute maximum drive of the Glencoe. Opportunities exist to host men's and women's teams, both domestic and foreign.

Host homes need to provide: a bed space for each rider, kitchen privileges and refrigerator space; garage or other safekeeping space for bicycles.

Host homes ARE NOT expected to provide: transportation; food; or non-team member, spouse, child, or pet accommodations. However, if a family would like to provide any of this; they are certainly not prevented from doing so. Most families do like to provide some shared meals, but are not expected to do so.

Host families are encouraged to engage with their guest racers, as experience shows that involved host families find the experience most rewarding when they connect with their guests.

Many families hold barbeques or other gatherings and invite family and friends to meet their guests! Many riders form friendships with host families and return year after year.
